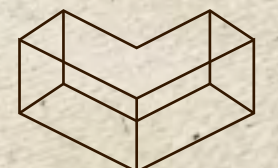


JAMES 5:10-11 NKJV

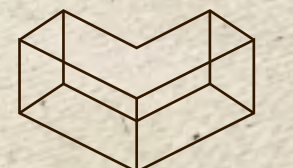

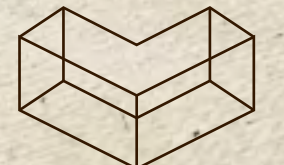
CORNERSTONE

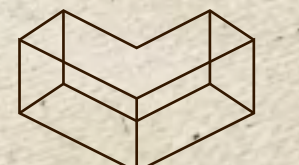

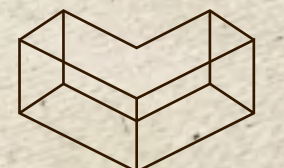

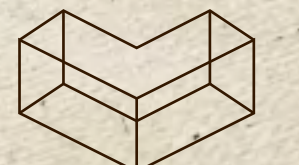

And this gospel of the Kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.



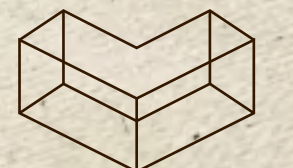
CORNERSTONE

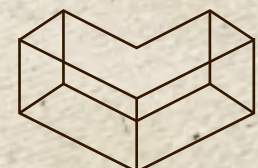

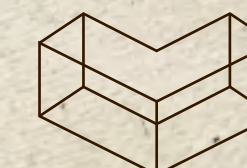

An **11-day** journey to Canaan **took 40 years;**

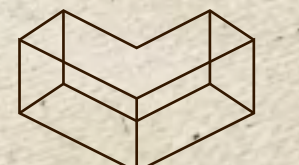
NUMBERS 14:34

2.5 tribes to have land on the East side of the Jordan.

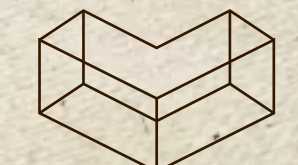
NUMBERS 32

all her house because she had faith.

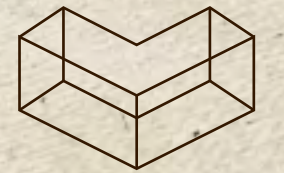

1 SAMUEL 8:7



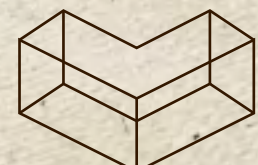
CORNERSTONE

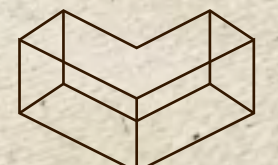
