#### Be assured of God's protection when we stay within the allotted boundaries.




# So in light of these scriptures, how do we conduct ourselves? Here are some principles.






### Satan is a defeated foe but he still retains his power.




### If we have to rebuke the adversary, then do what the scripture advises. Rebuke him in the **Name of the Lord.**




