


The Lord God planted a garden eastward in Eden, and there He put the man whom He had formed.






Throughout our lives, we'll have to choose from which tree we want to eat, because between them lies the focal point of the dichotomy between the Kingdom of God and this present evil age.






Old Testament: Caleb's Testimony
