




How do we thrive in such perilous times?






Ephesians 5:15 See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise.

  - Ephesians 4-6: what we must do in response FAITH



Ephesians 4:1 I, therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you to walk worthy of the calling with which you were called.



**Ephesians 5:2** And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma.

- 2. To walk wisely is the same call as:
  - C. To walk in the light.

Ephesians 5:8 For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light 9 (for the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is in all <u>goodness</u>, <u>righteousness</u>, and <u>truth</u>).

**Ephesians 2:10** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.



6. To walk wisely is to be <u>filled with the Spirit</u>.

Ephesians 3:19-20 - Overflow with LOVE 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. 20 Now to Him who is able to do **exceedingly** abundantly above all that we ask or think, <u>according to</u> the power that works in us.

7. To walk wisely is to <u>submit</u> to one another in the <u>fear</u> of God.

Ephesians 5:21 <u>submitting to one another</u> in <u>the fear of God</u>.

**Isaiah 11:2** The **Spirit of the Lord** shall rest upon Him, the **Spirit of wisdom** and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of **the fear of the Lord**.

**Proverbs 9:10** The <u>fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom</u>, and the knowledge of the Holy One is understanding.
