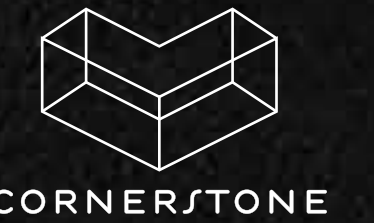
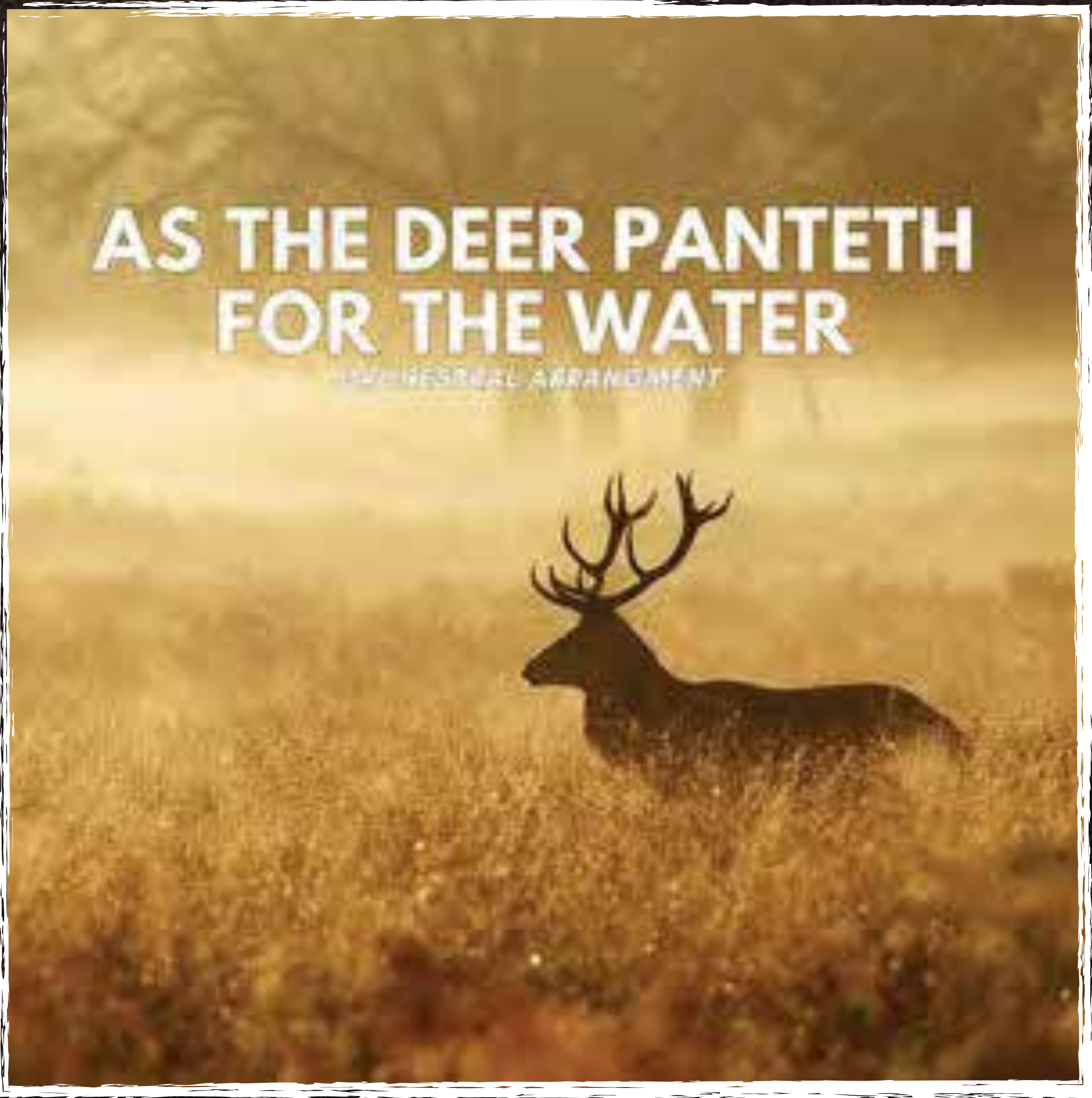
The revival is borne along upon billowing waves of **sacred song**. It is the **singing**, not the preaching, that is the instrument which is most efficacious in striking the hearts of men.

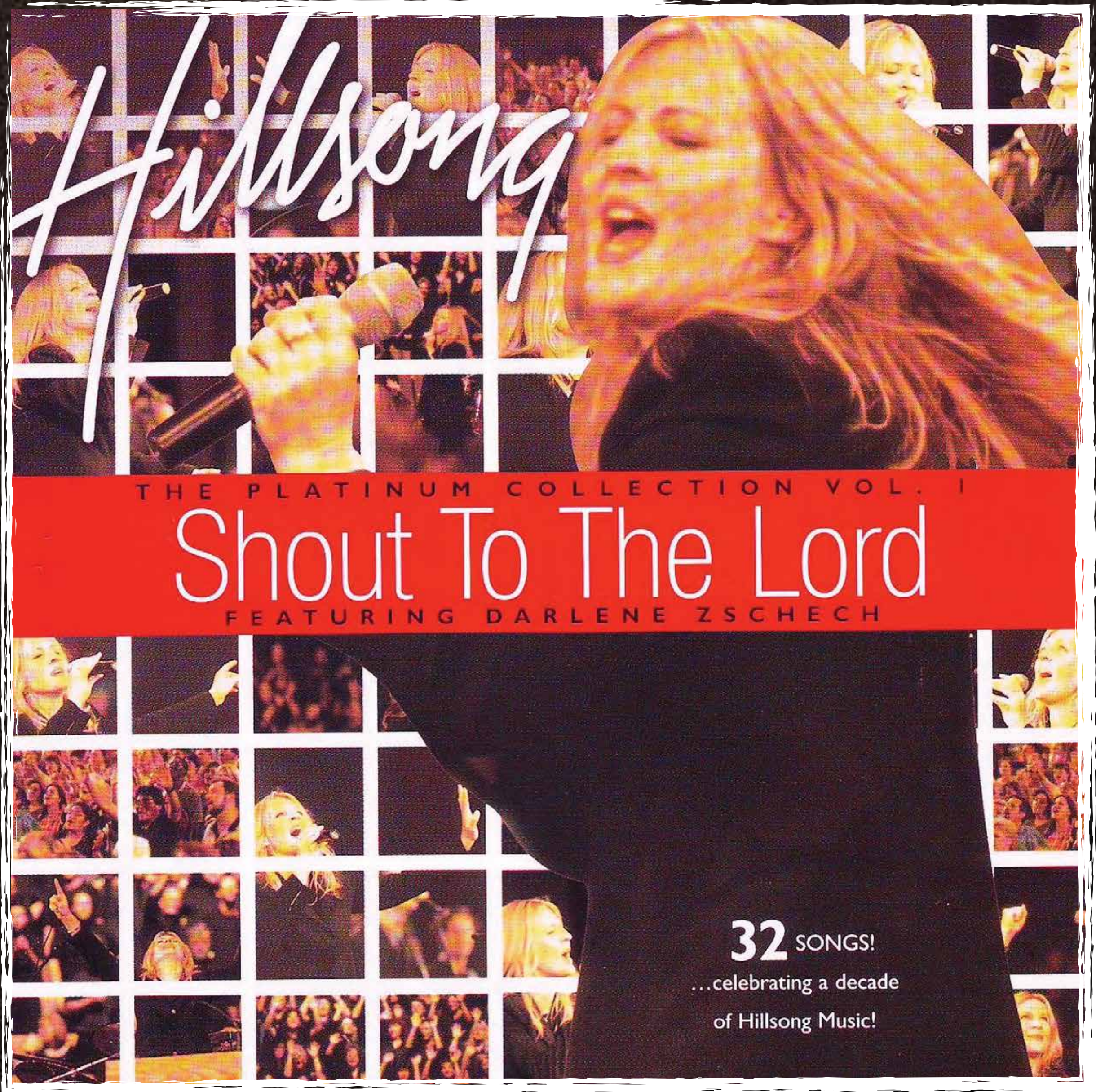

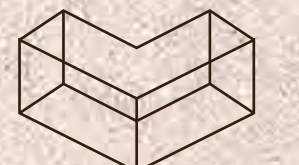
The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies
